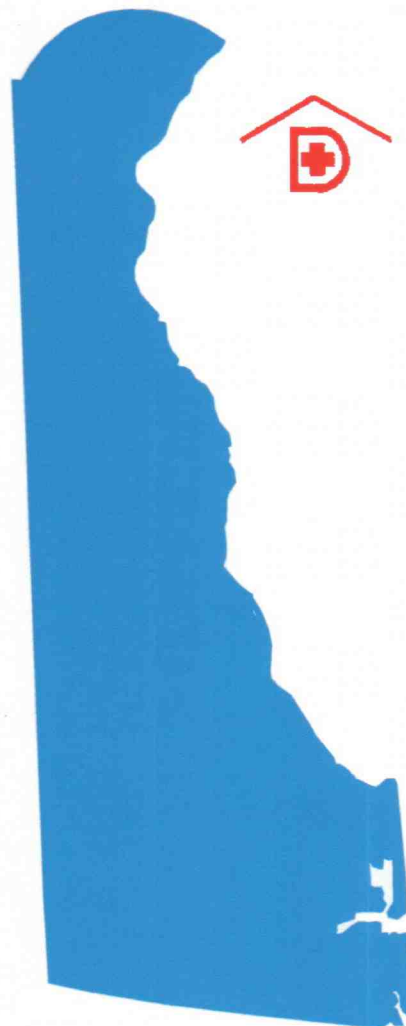

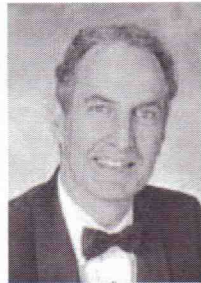

In 1999, Lane was appointed a member of the Council of American Politics, Graduate School of Political Management, George Washington University. In addition to that academic appointment, he serves on the Advisory Board for the Wertlieb Center for Long Term Care, School of Health Services and Leadership, George Washington University Medical Center.
