1. Marketing: Exposure and Education - Presenter: Pat Mitchell, North Carolina State University

2. ADA Functional Assessments

This session will present comprehensive new guidance and training materials developed by Easter Seals Project ACTION on using functional assessments to determine ADA paratransit eligibility. The role of functional assessments in an overall eligibility determination process will be discussed. The components of a comprehensive physical functional assessment will be presented and a new training CD on conducting physical functional assessments will be previewed. Materials that can be used to train staff to properly conduct assessments of cognitive transit skills will also be previewed. Recommended approaches for determining the eligibility of applicants with vision disabilities will also be discussed. The session is recommended for transit systems that now use functional assessments to determine ADA paratransit eligibility as well as those considering adding assessments to their process.
